HSAP is part of District 8 Division of the National Association of Parliamentarians (NAP), which also includes Arizona, California, Nevada, Utah, the Northern Mariana Islands, and Asia. The upcoming District 8 Conference will be held from July 23-25, 2015, in Las Vegas, Nevada, in conjunction with the American Institute of Parliamentarians (AIP) Annual Session.

The main purpose of the District 8 Conference is to elect a district director to provide representation of the district to NAP and to communicate information in both directions. There will be 14 educational workshops to attend as well.

Nā Lula Hālāwai

HSAP with support and a grant from the Office of Hawaiian Affairs has published Nā Lula Hālāwai: A Parliamentary Guide to Conducting Meetings in Hawaiian which was researched and written by our President, Dr. William J. Puette, PRP who teaches at UH West Oʻahu and Dr. Richard Keaoopuaokalani NeSmith (UH Mānoa). All members of HSAP in 2014 are entitled to a copy, but it is also available online as a free PDF on our website (www.hsap.org/halawai/).

Based on and cross-referenced to the 11th edition of *Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised*, the Hawaiian language parliamentary terminology used in this manual is derived and adapted from Rules of Order (*Nā Rula*) used in early Hawaiian legislatures between 1854 and 1909.
