

HAWAI'I STATE ASSOCIATION OF PARLIAMENTARIANS ("HSAP") Call to 2019 Biennial Convention

Aloha all,

I am the Vice-President of the Hawai'i State Association of Parliamentarians ("HSAP"), and I am pleased to invite you to attend our 2019 HSAP Biennial Convention in Aiea, Hawai'i. As a member of the National Association of Parliamentarians ("NAP") in Hawai'i you are also a member of HSAP, and are invited to attend this convention as a voting delegate.

The convention will be held on <u>Sunday, May 19, 2019 at 1:00 p.m.</u> at the Aiea Public Library, 99-374 Pohai Place, Aiea, Hawaii 96701. <u>Check-in begins at 12:30 p.m.</u>

The registration fee is \$5 if you RSVP (by responding to this email) on or before May 10, 2019. The fee is \$10 if you don't RSVP by the deadline. Registration fees will be payable upon check-in at the convention, and include the convention materials, a workshop taught by the District 8 Director, Vivian Vincent, and light refreshments.

The purpose of the convention is for the presentation of reports, election and installation of officers, selection of delegates and alternates to the 2019 NAP Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada, consideration of proposed amendments to the bylaws and standing rules, and any other business that may properly come before the assembly.

Notice is hereby given of the following proposed bylaw and standing rule amendments:

Bylaws, Article III, Section 1 – To increase the dues from \$10.00 to \$12.00 to allow pro-rating of dues depending on when the member joins, strike out \$10.00 and insert \$12.00 in the last sentence of the first paragraph ("Dues for all members are $\frac{$10.00}{$12.00}$ per year.").

Bylaws, Article III, Section 3 – To allow pro-rating of dues depending on when the member joins, strike out "not" from the last sentence of the paragraph ("HSAP dues shall not be pro-rated.").

Standing Rules, No. 4 – To allow more flexibility when providing a thank-you gift to the outgoing president, strike out "gavel, or appropriate memento, properly inscribed as a memento" and insert "gift" (The Immediate Past President shall be presented with a gavel, or appropriate memento, properly inscribed as a memento gift at a cost not to exceed \$100.00.")
